The Pine Mountain Lake Aviation Association invites everyone to our Annual Airport Day/Open House on October 2 from 12:00 – 3:00pm at the Pine Mountain Lake County Airport. This is a great *fun and free* way to see our airport and lots of interesting aircraft. Special events include a radio controlled model airplane demonstration at noon. At 12:30pm fly-overs and flying demonstrations begin. You'll see some amazing aerial work by our own Clay Lacey and stunning formation flying by "The Beech Boys" announcer from Reid-Hillview Airport in San Jose, will be describing the events. Jim is a walking encyclopedia of aircraft and makes the show interesting and educational. The flying contests begin at 1:30pm – including flour bombing and precision landing contests. In between special events, visitors can see lots of current and vintage planes up close. This is a great opportunity to check out your county airport, observe dozens of aircraft on display and meet many of our local pilots. PMLAA will be selling hot dogs and soft drinks for your convenience. *Admission is free.* Please use the Elderberry Way entrance to the airport. Bring folding chairs, if you like.
