- WASP (Women Airforce Service Pilots) The Forgotten Airforce
  - Transported every type of military aircraft from factories to airbases.
  - Towed targets for live anti-aircraft gun practice. YIKES!
  - Test-piloted newly repaired and experimental aircraft.
  - Trained male pilots.
  - Served at more than 120 bases around the country.
  - Logged more than 60 million miles of operational flights.
  - Delivered 12,650 military aircraft (more than half of all combat aircraft built in the US during World War II)

- Interesting (and even useful) information about Knots (/not/)
  - Knot is a unit of speed equal to one nautical mile per hour. A knot is approximately 1.15078 mph (1.852 km/h)
  - The knot is used in meteorology, maritime navigation, and air navigation.
  - The term 'knot' is from the 17th century, when sailors measured the speed of their ship using a device called a "common log." It was a coil of rope with uniformly spaced **knots**, attached to a piece of wood shaped like a slice of pie.
