President's Message By Bob Mackey

After our September meeting with guest Paul Marshall from CalDART, the Pine Mountain Lake Airport Association hosted the first CalDART simulated emergency exercise at E45. Sunday morning, immediately after the hangar cleanup, we performed a successful CalDART practice mission with 7 pilots, 3 aircraft, and 11 total volunteers. The mission delivered 7 humanitarian aid packages to the disaster-stricken neighbors at Columbia Airport, along with a team of volunteers.

A successful mission includes an honest debrief to understand what we did, how we did it, and what we would do differently next time. In this debrief, one key question is whether we achieved the critical mass needed to make this an ongoing successful organization able to support future airlift missions. We agreed that we have in fact achieved critical mass, and will move forward as the new "Tuolumne DART" with Bob Mackey and Lionel Hunt as the initial contact points and training leaders. This organization is separate from PMLAA and from EAA 1337, but expect to hear more about it here and on the CalDART website. Thanks to Paul Marshall, Darren Jarvis, Ralph McLaughlin, Lionel Hunt, Steve Griefer, Nora Feddal, Phil Boortz, Rich McGlashen, Juan Barrios, Karen Reyes, Jason Johanson, and Krystall Johanson for all your contributions to this successful launch.

They are famous for their restorations of Beech 18 twins, and related warbird aircraft like the RC-45J or SNB-5P. Taigh has also been involved in historical remembrance and reenactments, including the 75th anniversary of the end of WWII. Recently, he was a technical advisor in the making of Masters of the Air, an Apple TV+ production covering the life of a B17 bomber group operating out of England. It was Taigh's work that made so many of the scenes realistic and accurate. If you haven't seen the series already, consider watching it before the November meeting so you can ask great questions of the experts.
